We are Witnesses / Martyrs of Jesus—Unto Death

8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” 9 And when he had said these things, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. 10 And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, 11 and said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven.” Acts 1:8-11

Forty days after Jesus’ resurrection from the grave, He ascended into heaven. As He was lifted into the clouds Jesus gave them **a final message** and **a final promise** to return in the same way He left them. This ascension took place at Bethany, on the Mount of Olives, a short distance from Jerusalem. Jesus **final message to the disciples is to inform them that they will be His witnesses** beginning at Jerusalem, followed by Judea and Samaria and continuing their witness to the ends of the earth.

To be a witness is also the Greek term for martyr. To be a martyr is to be someone who dies for what they believe to be true. The apostles became those witnesses of Jesus. As they told this good news of Jesus’ death and resurrection with the call for listeners to repent and be baptized, they were literally killed, martyred, as witness of Jesus Christ. From being stoned to death, crucified upside down, burned or skinned alive for the witness of their faith. Are we willing to die for our Christian faith? We declare to the church that we

are willing to do the same as we speak our confirmation vows at church. Our confirmation vows ask two specific questions that include our witness unto death concerning our faith in Jesus Christ.

Lutheran Service Book page 273 “**Do you intend to live according to the Word of God, and in faith, word, and deed to remain true to God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit even to death?**” along with “**Do you intend to continue steadfast in this confession and Church and to suffer all, even death, rather than fall away for it?**”

We answer both of these questions with “*I do, by the grace of God.*”

Like the witnesses of old, we declare our willingness to die for the Savior we believe in. Thanks be to God that we have not been put to the test on this item, however, many in the world continue to make the difficult decision to deny their faith and live on earth or confess their faith and to be separated from their life on earth with death.

May we be eternally grateful for the witnesses of the apostles and the witness of the church through the ages that carried their witness to Prince of Peace and all who confess our Savior’s name. May God continue to inspire our bold confession of faith, carrying this message of salvation to the ends of the earth. I look forward to confessing this faith with you this week at Prince of Peace.

100 CALORIE BROWNIES

Ingredients

- 3 oz. unsweetened chocolate, chopped
- 3/4 c. flour
- 3 egg whites
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1 c. sugar
- 3/4 c. 2% lowfat cottage cheese
- 1 tsp. vanilla

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Melt chocolate. Cool slightly. Puree *all* ingredients. Pour into lightly buttered 8 inch square pan. Bake 20 to 25 minutes. Sprinkle with powdered sugar. Makes 16.
